## Sterilisation: Purchasing of Reusable Medical Devices (RMDs) and reprocessing equipment

### SESLHDPR/307

### 1. POLICY STATEMENT

To establish that the cleaning and sterilisation methods available in the reprocessing facility are compatible with the RMDs to be purchased and those on Loan.

Health Service organisations (HSOs) shall ensure sufficient reprocessing equipment is available to meet the needs of the reprocessing facility.

### BACKGROUND 2.

Prior to purchasing of RMDs that require reprocessing, consultation shall take place between the Sterilising Services Managers, Equipment Managers and Medical Staff to establish that the RMD can successfully undergo the available/intended complete reprocessing steps.

If all steps of reprocessing the RMD cannot be successfully completed, it shall not be reprocessed.

Prior to purchase of equipment required for reprocessing reference shall be made to the relevant ISO Standards.

### RESPONSIBILITIES 3.

### 3.1 **Employees will:**

- Comply with the requirements of this procedure
- Report non-compliance with this procedure.

### 3.2 Line Managers will:

Inform Equipment Managers, Purchasing Officers and Supplier Representatives of the requirement of this procedure.

### 3.3 **District Managers/Service Managers will:**

Implement the requirements of this procedure.

### Medical staff will: 3.4

Comply with the requirements of this procedure.

### PROCEDURE 4.

4.1 Sterilising Services Manager shall be consulted prior to purchasing RMDs ensuring manufacturer's IFUs for reprocessing are considered.

Establish that the RMDs can be successfully reprocessed by completing Clinical Product Evaluation Form.

A risk assessment will be performed if required and advise will be provided as to whether purchasing can proceed.
