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Calling for Expression of Interest (EOI) from Local Aboriginal Artists or Designers

Who we are:

South Eastern Sydney Local Health District (SESLHD) provides healthcare services across seven Local Government Areas (LGAs) from Sydney's Central Business District in the north to the Royal National Park in the south, with hospitals located at Randwick, Kogarah, Caringbah and Sydney.

St George Hospital is a large tertiary referral acute public hospital providing services across the lifespan and in both inpatient and outpatient settings. Based in Kogarah, St George Hospital provides health services to our local community and encompasses the local government areas of Bayside and Georges River. In order to provide the best care that we can, St George Hospital is committed to identifying meaningful ways to connect to our local community.

Artwork Concept:

The purpose of these artworks is to provide visual representation that reflects the work undertaken by St George Hospital with an aligned purpose.

We are seeking two (2) artworks that will reflect this concept and also the core values and business of St George Hospital, which supports Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander health and wellbeing. The locations of each artwork is as follows:

Key themes that could be potentially included in the artwork are:

- Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander health
- Wellbeing
- Culture
- Community
- Collaboration
- Openness
- Respect
- Empowerment

The artwork will be used as an identifiable image of St George Hospital and will be displayed at the entrance to the above-mentioned rooms. In addition, the artwork may be included on promotional resources including printed and digital publications, social media, webpage, and clothing.

Submitting an EOI:

Artists/designers should submit concept designs on A3 sized paper or as an email attachment. The design should be accompanied by a supporting statement/story describing the artwork as part of the EOI. Individual and collaborative works are accepted as are contemporary and/or traditional art forms.

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EOI submissions close on 30 April 2023.

Successful submission:

The successful submission selected to be the most appropriate entry, by a panel, will be eligible to receive a fee of \$2500 GST inclusive (\$1000 payable to the artist on acceptance of the design; and \$1500 payable to the artist on the delivery of the final artwork).

Please note: All finished artwork, that is, the artwork for which the stated fee is paid, will be the property of St George Hospital. As owners of the copyright of the finished artwork, St George Hospital may use the artwork or part thereof for its promotional activities as required.

Terms and conditions in relation to the Commissioned Artwork:

- The value of the fee/commission to the successful applicant is \$2500 (GST inc) as per the agreed contract on the following schedule: \$1000 payable to the artist upon acceptance of the design; and \$1500 payable to the artist upon delivery of the final artwork.
- The artist is to sign an agreement outlining the approved use of the artwork.
- The legal title to the artwork (ownership) will be with St George Hospital.
- St George Hospital will permit the artist to use the artwork for their own personal business
 activities which includes the following: Promotion of their artistic works and style; use on their
 websites and social media as an example of their work but not as part of their website/logo
 design.
- The artist agrees that the artwork will not be reproduced, sold or used by any other entity.
- St George Hospital will have the right in perpetuity to use and reproduce the artwork and/or a portion of the artwork in its promotional activities and materials.
- The artist will be formally recognised as the artist of the artwork (where practicable).

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- St George Hospital will have worldwide rights to use the artwork across all media.
- St George Hospital will have the right to edit and modify the artwork for reproduction purposes.
- No further or ongoing payment will be made by St George Hospital to the artist other than the commission fee payment.
- The artist on signing of any document is accepting the Terms and Conditions of the commissioning and future use of the artwork by St George Hospital
- St George Hospital at its discretion may stop using the artwork at any time.

Unsuccessful EOIs submitted:

- Submitting artists or their nominees can collect their EOI/artwork within one (1) month of the successful EOI being selected.
- EOIs can either be collected in person or posted to a nominated address. (St George Hospital will pay for the postage)
- While the St George Hospital will take all care of the safekeeping of the artwork, however no responsibility will be accepted in the case of loss or damages.

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
