## **Medicine Guideline**

## For preparation of XYLOCAINE(Lidocaine) 2% with Adrenaline 1:200000 using individual components



Areas where Protocol/Guideline	Operating Theatres - The Royal Hospital for Women
applicable	Preparation to be undertaken by Anaesthetists ONLY
Authorised Prescribers	Anaesthetists
Indication for use	Caesarean Section and other obstetric procedures performed under epidural anaesthesia where alternative anaesthetic agents are not suitable (e.g. bupivacaine or ropivacaine).
Individual Components Required for Preparation	<ul> <li>Lidocaine 400 mg/20 mL (2%) ampoule (Xylocaine®) Polyamp DuoFit ampoules as Sterile Theatre Pack</li> <li>Adrenaline 1 mg/10 mL (1: 10,000) ampoule</li> </ul>
Other Items Required	3mL syringe, 30 mL syringe (or other appropriate size syringe) and drawing up needle (sterile)
Proposed Place in Therapy	This protocol is endorsed for use ONLY during disruption of supply of <i>Xylocaine 2%</i> with Adrenaline 1:200000® and until alternative equivalent preparations are available.
Preparation Instructions	Instructions  1. Draw up 1 mL (0.1 mg) of Adrenaline 1 mg/10 mL (1:10,000) using a 3mL syringe  2. Draw up 20 mL (400 mg) of Lidocaine (Xylocaine®) 2% using an appropriate sized syringe.  3. Transfer 1mL of Adrenaline to syringe containing Lidocaine to make final volume of 21mL.  Labelling  The final syringe MUST be labelled in accordance with National Standard for Userapplied Labelling of Injectable Medicines Fluids and Lines. Each medicine must be listed on a new line on the syringe label.
Precautions	Note: Adrenaline 1:10,000 amp is NOT provided in a Sterile Theatre Pack The solution must be prepared with a sterile, unused syringe and drawing up needle, using a no touch or sterile technique.
