

Our hospital and program

Sydney Hospital and Sydney Eye Hospital (SSEH) is located on the site of Australia's first Hospital – right in the heart of the vibrant city of Sydney!

Sydney Hospital provides general and specialist health care to the public and community including 24hour emergency care services, general medicine including a close observation unit, peri-operative services, day surgery and specialist hand surgery. Sydney Hospital's dedicated Hand Unit is a centre of excellence and tertiary referral centre for hand trauma, abnormalities, and diseases of the hand.

Sydney Eye Hospital is a centre of excellence and quaternary referral centre for eye health conditions. It performs a vast amount of public eye surgery and provides emergency eye care, ophthalmic health services for inpatient/ outpatient and community outreach programs.

The Transition to Professional Practice Population and Community Health (PaCH) Stream is a unique program in partnership with our Population and Community Health colleagues, which will enable you to experience working in an acute inpatient setting in our hospital and a primary health setting.

Typical six-month rotations with PaCH, will be in any of the following areas:

Child Youth and Family Services Drug and Alcohol Service Integrated Care Blood Borne Virus/ Sexual Health Services including: the Kirketon Road Centre, HIV Outreach and the Albion Centre

Transition Framework

Our Transition to Professional Practice Framework incorporates the four core transition principles of induction, person-centred work culture, learning and development, and support.

The Registered Nurse Program – Population and Community Health Stream, is designed to develop and enhance your skills and knowledge as a first year Registered Nurse to implement safe, quality patient care within a supported clinical learning environment. We take great pride in enabling transitioning nurses to develop as competent, responsible and accountable Registered Nurses.

Our Transition to Professional Practice Program is committed to a person centred and facilitated learning approach, whereby you as the transitioning nurse continue to be self-determining and responsible for your learning and professional development.

By selecting Sydney Hospital/Sydney Eye Hospital - Population and Community Health Stream, our Transition to Professional Practice Program over the six months you are with us, offers the following:

- o Nursing experience in a specialist teaching hospital in the heart of Sydney
- o Five day corporate and tailored nursing orientation program
- One rotation at Sydney Hospital/Sydney Eye Hospital in an acute inpatient area, over a 6-month period (you will then transfer to a primary health setting for a further 6-month rotation)
- Ongoing support, guidance and facilitation from preceptors and other clinical resource staff including clinical nurse educators, nurse educator, clinical nurse consultants and a nurse manager who is responsible for the implementation and management of the Transition to Professional Practice Program
- A regular program of first year transitioning nurse tailored education sessions, including access to the hospital wide in-service program, access to Study Leave and closed group Clinical Supervision to support reflective practice.
- Nursing employment following completion of the program in a department/unit/ward based on position availability
- o NSW Health State-wide uniforms
- o Annual leave
- o Individualised career pathway planning and development
- Certificate of Achievement on completion of Transition to Professional Practice Population and Community Health Stream Program

At Sydney Hospital/Sydney Eye Hospital we receive excellent feedback from our first year Transitioning to Professional Practice Registered Nurses and pride ourselves on the high retention rate following completion of their 12-month program.

Transport

Located in the heart of Australia's most exciting and multicultural city, situated in picturesque grounds, the historical Sydney Hospital/Sydney Eye Hospital is just a 10-minute stroll from the magnificent Sydney Harbour, including the Opera House and Botanical Gardens, and adjacent to the best shopping, food and entertainment facilities imaginable.

All of this and more is easily accessible with a 24-hour public transport network. The hospitals are close to Town Hall, St James, Wynyard and Martin Place train stations. Buses operate continuously from Sydney's Central Business District. Ferries arrive at Circular Quay, which is just a ten-minute walk away.
