This factsheet provides information about planned care available at our service.



NSW maternity and neonatal care

During your pregnancy and after your baby is born, we want to give you both the best possible care. NSW hospitals have levels of care from 1-6 to meet the different needs of mothers and babies. All hospitals are linked to a Level 6 hospital which offers the highest (most complex) level of care..

Our services

We are a **Level 6 Maternity Service** which means we can care for women and their babies with a range of needs during pregnancy and after birth, including those who require complex medical care.

More specialised care

A very small number of women and babies may require specialist medical care from another Level 6 hospital. If you need this, we have pathways to ensure you and your baby receive the care you need. We understand it is important for mothers and babies to stay together and be cared for as close to home as possible.

If we need to transfer your care

We know it can be difficult for your family if you need to move to a hospital further from home. We have services available like social work and Aboriginal liaison officers that can help your family with organising transport, accommodation and financial help.

We encourage you to ask questions about your individual situation and take time to consider our recommendations.
